

## Tell Us What You Think About QPL's Spending Priorities for Fiscal Year 2021

May 18, 2020

To the Queens Public Library Community:

We hope you, your families, and colleagues are healthy and safe during this unprecedented moment in our history. Queens Public Library closed its locations on Monday, March 16 to help slow the spread of the coronavirus but continues to serve the public remotely.

More than two months into our transition, we have continued to make possible the delivery of critical services digitally to individuals and families in Queens and beyond.

Through virtual programming and resources, we are offering employment assistance, technology skills development, storytimes, health discussions, cultural programs, remote learning opportunities, Census 2020 support, an expanded eBook collection, live chats with librarians, and more. We also have helped provide people continued Internet access through Wi-Fi service that extends beyond the walls of our buildings.

Between last July and the first two weeks of March, the Library welcomed 7.4 million people to its 66 locations, offered tens of thousands of programs, and circulated its materials 7.8 million times. In addition, more than 2.3 million customers used our computers or logged onto our Wi-Fi network.

We are now in the process of revising our budget for Fiscal Year 2021, which begins July 1, 2020. We want everyone in Queens to understand how QPL is looking to spend its limited dollars and to tell us what you think of our current priorities for next year, understanding they may change in the event of a decline in City and State funding due to the ongoing pandemic. We welcome you to share your perspective, in written form, at a public hearing to be held electronically on May 21, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

Your feedback is essential as we work to plan for the future. If you are unable to attend the hearing, you can send written comments about the proposed budget through our <u>website</u>, prior to the hearing, as well as after the hearing until June 23, 2020.


